**Friday, August 11<sup>th</sup> is the last day to register online!!!** We would like to encourage all parents to create a Denver Public School's Parent Portal Account. A Parent Portal Account gives you access to your child's academic and attendance records including report cards. Parent Portal makes your life easier! You would no longer need to fill out lengthy paper registration forms in the fall and in January when the Choice process begins, you can fill out the Choice paperwork on-line. However, you have to sign up to get all the benefits of Parent Portal. Only one account is needed for all your students in Denver Public Schools.

**The new and improved version of the DPS Portal mobile app** is now available for download and includes new features that allow parents and students to better monitor academic progress on a deeper level. This new app is available in the Apple Store and the Google Play Store by searching "DPS Portal."

The new mobile app has made many improvements. The loading times are incredibly fast; it's fully translated in 10 languages; you can see all of the course assignments and gradebook details; and the next update at the end of the month will also include the attendance details. You can download the new mobile app by searching "DPS Portal" in the Apple Store or the Google Play Store.

If you have not created a Parent Portal Account, please go to [myportal.dpsk12.org](http://myportal.dpsk12.org) and click on "Getting Started. You will need an email address and one of your student's ID numbers. You can create your account immediately.
