

NON-STUDENT CONTACT DAYS

Planning, conference, assessment, and professional days (no classes for students; 11.5 days total)

Aug. 10-14, September 28; Oct. 16, 19-20; Jan. 4; Feb. 19; April 5; May 28 (half day).

3 Centrally offered professional learning days: Aug. 11; Oct 19; Feb. 16.

Non-student contact days breakdown: Minimum of 4.5 full self-directed teacher planning days to be distributed in meaningful increments; 3 full professional development days to be directed by the principal; 3 days for data culture/analysis; 1 family conference day.

Notes: SLT to determine which non-student contact days are planning vs. professional. Attendance at centrally offered professional learning is at school leader discretion, but some flexibility decisions will require teacher attendance on these days.
