- No school on Monday September 3rd have a great Labor Day weekend.
- Today we practiced all of our safety drills! We had a Fire Drill, a Shelter-In-Place/Severe Weather Drill and a Lockdown Drill. - IB Learner Profile: Inquirers. We had Science Buddies yesterday. Students spent time asking questions about what scientists do and wondering about science. Students also got to know their Science Buddy by drawing a picture of a scientist. Ask you child about what they wonder about science.
- **Students Health:** We are moving into the season where allergies and colds become more common. Please keep your child home if they have a fever of 100 or more without medication. Students are supposed to stay home 24 hours after a fever to ensure they are not contagious. If you know your child will be missing school for illness, Doctor/Dentist visit or family event, please call the attendance line at 720-424-9398.
- Please observe and use the crosswalks. **DO NOT** cross at any other area OR call your student to cross the street. Do not have your car block the crosswalk at any time.
- Handicap zones are for clearly marked handicap vehicles only.
- The "Kiss and Go" cone zone at the main entrance is for a quick drop-off only. Please pull as far forward as possible. Drivers should not exit the car or linger and watch your student walk to the front doors as this causes congestion for those behind you. If you need to assist your student, please park across the

street. This area is specifically designated for a quick drop-off only and we need to have cars move on.

• The teacher parking lot is **not an area to drop-off or pick-up students** before or after school.
