Classroom Curriculum

This school year has an overarching theme for students of all grades to consider. This is consistent with many state and district art education standards. Bradley artists are instructed and encouraged to tell a story with their art. Art is a form of communication and students will be taught in a variety of ways to choose a theme or message for their art and then use elements of art such as colors, lines and details to make their message clear to their viewers. This year-long focus is producing some great enthusiasm in the kids. Their art is so personal and their questions about 'what do I add next?' or the ageless 'is it done now?' are not being asked.



One essential IB skill is to 'be a communicator'. Within the IB communication skill set 'be a listener' is also important. In art, students will learn how to look at art and understand the details that tell the story. Fascinatingly, children have a unique way of understanding each others art. In art class this year, there is an unusual amount of appreciation for each other's creations, a lot of swapping art stories and an encouraging dialog among peers who help each other with ideas on how to improve each others art. The desire in every classroom is to harness the attention that friends give to each other for the subject matter being taught!

Parents are an essential support for their children. When art comes home, dedicate a few minutes of undivided attention to listen to its carefully created message from your student. There is so much to learn about children through their art; even with the children we know so well.
