

Bradley Calendar for i-Ready Interim Assessments

Bradley students will take their midyear interim assessments during the month of January. All assessments are to be completed by January 31st. Teachers will analyze BOY (Beginning of Year) and MOY (Midyear) data along with a body of evidence to determine student performance and areas of need for reteach and differentiated instruction. The i-Ready diagnostic is also used to tailor the online curriculum to each student's individual needs.

I-Ready is our chosen assessment tool for students in grades K-5. Students will complete their assessments in the classrooms on Chromebooks/Laptops or in the Computer Lab. Each test (reading and math) takes approximately one hour with it taking a little longer in grades K-2. This is not a timed test and students are able to complete with as much time as they need.

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| Assessment Calendar | Bradley students take the i-Ready Diagnostics for reading and math three times per year, once at the beginning of the year (August/September), once at midyear (January) and again at the end of the year (April/May). Each interim takes approximately one hour with it taking a little longer in the primary grades. In the younger grades, the diagnostic may be broken up into several sessions over the course of a few days. |
| How will you use the data from these assessments? | The i-Ready Diagnostics are used to inform teaching and help teachers plan for differentiation. They allow students to access the Ready curriculum at their current level of performance. Teachers use the data from the assessments along with a body of evidence to determine student growth and areas of need for reateach. The i-Ready reading diagnostic is also used to determine which students are qualify for a Read Plan under the Colorado State Read Act. |
| Assessment Format | i-Ready Diagnostics are taken online using a desk top computer, a laptop or a Chromebook. |
| Grades | All students in grades Kindergarten through 5th take the i-Ready reading and math diagnostics. |
