Read Here For An Update from Councilwoman Kendra Black on Yale Construction... Councilwoman Kendra Black hosted a public meeting on Wednesday, December 13<sup>th</sup> to discuss the construction that will take place on Yale Street, between Dahlia and Glencoe. Starting in the new year, a large drainage system will be installed that will help prevent the increased flooding risk happening in this area along Yale. Traffic disruptions will be a daily occurrence. At some point the intersection of Yale and Dahlia will actually be closed and pedestrian traffic will be hindered as well. The engineers for the project said they are committed to making this whole process happen as fast and safe as possible. If you typically travel on Yale to get to Bradley for drop-off or pick-up of your students, you will want to come up with an alternate route once the construction begins.
