- We had a fantastic 1st week of school!! The students are doing a great job! Look for your child's Friday Folder which will include notes from the teacher, our Bradley calendar magnet as well as a color calendar inserted on the back of the Friday Folder for easy access. Please return the purple Friday folders on Monday.
- IB Learner Profile: Risk-Taker Ask your students about the first week of school Who did they meet? Who did they sit by at lunch? Did they ask the teacher any questions during math?
- Please recognize the school zones and keep your speeds to 20 mph or lower as you drop-off and pick-up students.
- Please observe and use the crosswalks. **DO NOT** cross at any other area OR call your student to cross the street. Do not have your car block the crosswalk at any time.
- **Handicap zones** are for clearly marked handicap vehicles only.
- The "Kiss and Go" cone zone at the main entrance is for a quick drop-off only. Drivers should not exit the car or linger and watch your student walk to the front doors as this causes congestion for those behind you. If you need to assist your student, please park across the street. This area is specifically designated for a quick drop-off only and we need to have cars move on.
- The teacher parking lot is **not an area to drop-off or pick-up students** before or after school.
