The Generation Teach STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering,

Art, Math) Academy is a free 5- or 6-week summer academic acceleration program for middle-school students. The GT STEAM Academy (GTSA) introduces students to engineering and social justice, accelerates math and reading skills, and provides four electives of their choice (art, dance, sports, and world languages). Free breakfast and lunch are served daily. Fun Fridays feature field trips, team competitions, and games.
