We have learned about how pollution continues to accumulate in the oceans and the effect it is having on the coral reefs, kelp forests, animals, and more. 4Ocean collects ocean trash and recycles it to create bracelets from the glass, plastic and metal they collect. One bracelet sold generates enough money to collect up to one pound of trash. Each month *4Ocean* partners with a conservation cause and features a special bracelet color to tie-in with their cause.

You purchase a bracelet and fund cleanup efforts.

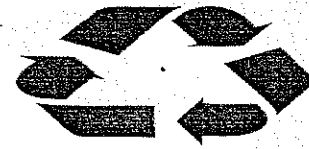


2.
