



Happy Holidays! We hope you all have a wonderful break. In this folder, you will find several activities and games to do with your child. Please adjust the activities to meet your child's needs. I have included some suggestions below. The dice, beads, book, and stickers are our gift to the kids so please keep them at home to enjoy similar activities. Your child has worked really hard on a gift for you, so please make sure you open it. Thank you, and have fun ☺

Countdown Calendar: Use the stickers provided to have your child put a sticker on the calendar every day. This will help them learn how many days remain until they come back to school. When it gets close, please prepare and talk to them about school.

Beads: Use the beads and pipe cleaners for some fun, fine motor practice. This activity could be turned into a pattern and kiddos could create a candy cane (red, white or red, red, white, white).

Dice Game: Use the Gingerbread number sheet and provided dice to play this game. Have your child roll the dice and count. Have them connect the quantity to the numeral. This activity can be modified as well. Help your child count and then find the number or have them match it.

Present Beginning Sound: Use the sheet provided and have your child say what is inside the present. Help them connect the sound to the letter. Have your students write, copy, or trace the letter.

Letter Tracing and Name Writing: Please have you child practice tracing and writing their letters and names. There is a letter tracing sheet and lined paper provided in the packet.

Reading Log: Throughout the break, please have your child log their reading. For every book they read or that is read to them, please have them color a mitten. Return Reading Logs on our first day back on Monday, January 7th.

Stickers: Have your child use the alphabet stickers to spell their name or different words. Have them put the number stickers in order. After using the stickers to spell their name, have you child write their name! This can also be fun fine motor practice!

These activities are not meant to be done in one day or night, work through what you are able and return back to school on Tuesday, January 7th. There will be prizes for any part of the completed assignment.

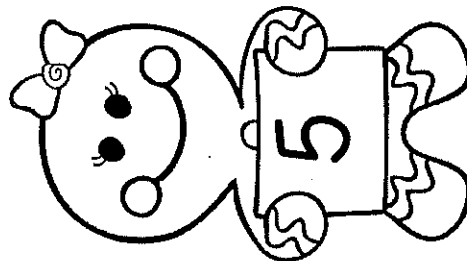
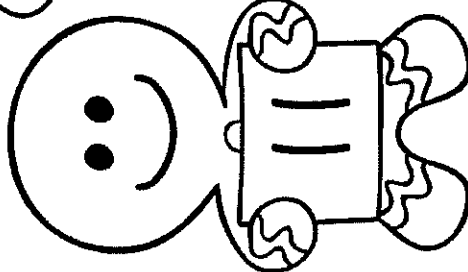
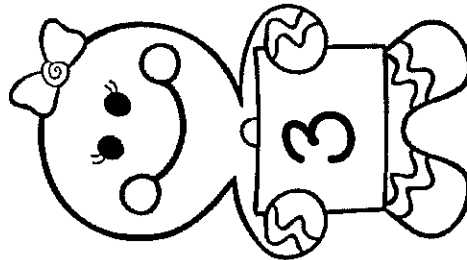
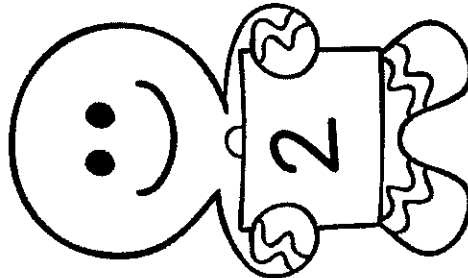
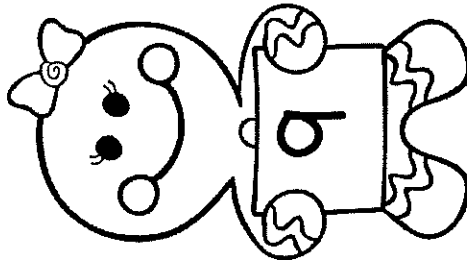
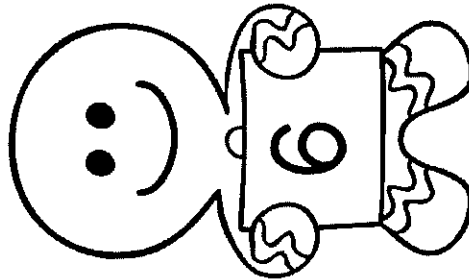
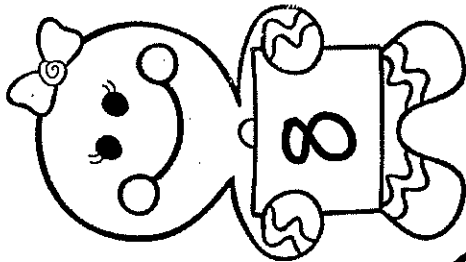
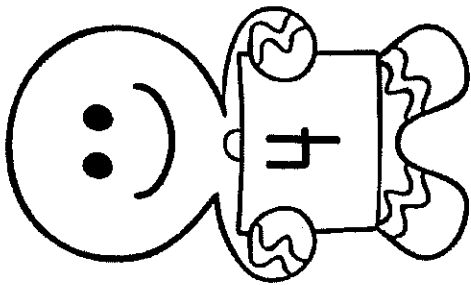
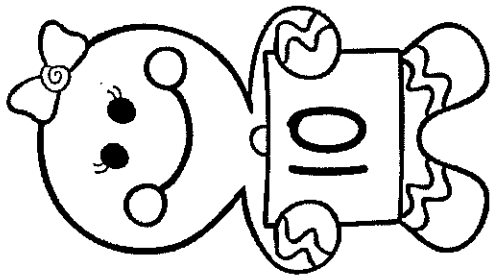
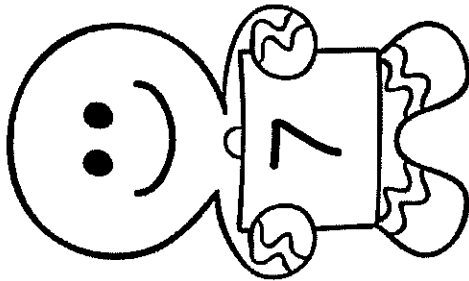
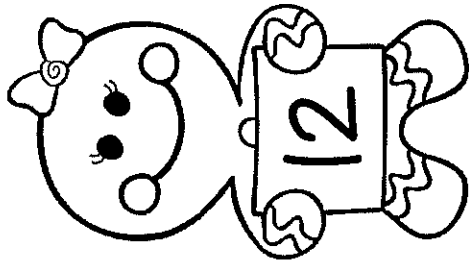
