

Dear Bradley Parents:

I just wanted to let you know that today we practiced a school-wide SEVERE WEATHER or SHELTER-IN-PLACE drill, a FIRE drill and a Lockdown. Below is a brief description of today's drills to help you understand the importance of these types of events.

SEVERE WEATHER or SHELTER-IN-PLACE DRILLS

The "Shelter-in-Place" drill will be conducted 1 time a semester each school year. The purpose of this drill is to be prepared to move to a safe location within the building in case of severe weather such as hail storms or tornados.

FIRE DRILLS

The school will conduct a "fire drill" each month that school is in session. This is a Fire Code requirement as well as a requirement by Denver Public Schools. We want each student to understand and be aware of the importance of this drill and not be afraid when the fire alarm is sounded. By practicing, they will know what to do and how to do it.

LOCKDOWN

Lockdown drills occur one time each semester. Students are moved quickly, safely and quietly to areas inside the building and no one will be allowed in the building during a lockdown.

Please remember that these safety practice drills are done to help maintain our school as a safe place to learn and work.

Make sure to ask and discuss these drills with your child.
